<u>Condition of Plot</u> Plots should be well stocked with crops, free from Obvious signs of pests and disease. Unplanted areas, Where crops have just been harvested or are to be Planted should be clean and free from weeds. The Soil should be in a good, well cultivated condition And texture.	60	
<u>Good Workmanship</u> Soil between crops should show few or no weeds. Any paths or leisure areas must be well maintained. Evidence of planting for succession will be given credit. Good use of organic methods for pest control.	50	
<u>Quality of Crops/flowers</u> All plants should be sturdy and healthy. A wide range of crops should be grown. Flowers will be judged on health and suitability. Inclusion of culinary herbs will be meritorious.	150	
<u>Visual Aspects of Plot</u> Overall appearance of the plot should be neat and pleasing. Balance of cultivation should be broad.	20
